



My name is Samantha. Unlike most people who come here to keep from going to prison, I paroled out here from prison. Due to my criminal lifestyle and meth addiction my family would not allow me to come home. So I took a chance and wrote to PNS about my situation and the need for structure and the Lord in my life. I was locked up for 13 months before coming here and honestly I could see nothing good ahead of me. I was missing precious time with my son and baby and had come to the point of giving up when I received my acceptance letter. From that point on things began looking up for me because of this program and the changes I am making. I talk to my family twice a week and can honestly say I see myself living for the Lord drug free and happy. Thanks to the Lord, PNS and my strong will and determination I will be a great mom to my son and little one along with a productive member of society instead of a menace.

My name is Katherine. I was a liar, a thief and a junkie. I was to a point in my life where I would rather die high than to live without the drugs. I was a hopeless case and my family told me they were going to start planning my funeral. I am 22 and I was facing prison time when I came to Project New Start where Jesus found me and now my life is better than it ever was. I have my family and my life back. I am a new person in Christ Jesus and I am no longer defined by my past mistakes.

My name is Kelley Michelle. I am 41 years old. I have two daughters that are now grown. I didn't raise my daughters due to drugs. I used marijuana and meth heavily for 20 years. I came to Project New Start on October 27, 2011. I was desperately wanting to change my life or end it. I faced many obstacles but got through it with the help I needed through the Word of God being fed to me daily. I've been drug free since September 23, 2011 and I graduated on April 27, 2012. God has given me a job, restoration with my children, a husband, a car and a home. I am blessed daily. Thank you Christ Jesus for my new life.

My name is Brett Casey and I'm 38 years old. I have struggled with drugs and alcohol all of my adult life. I was a liar, a con, and an addict. Every time things were going good in my life, the drugs would take it all from me. My family didn't want anything to do with me anymore. The drugs were taking my life away. I made a decision to come to Project New Start where I renewed my relationship with God. God has restored my life and given me back the things the devil had taken from me. God has delivered me from my addictions and blessed me with a job here at Project New Start where I can help others overcome their addictions. I am very happy to be a King's Kid serving my Father in Heaven. Thank You Lord.


My name is Chad Tillman. I started out in life like a lot of people did, social drinking as a teenager. The more I would drink the more I liked it and shortly after my teenage years it came to be an everyday event in my life. I always told my family that I could control it but now I realize that it was just one of many lies that the devil told me. By the time I was in my mid twenties by society standards I was a full blown alcoholic. I had let alcohol control me and everything in my life. Alcohol had become an idol to me, it didn't take very long for me to start getting in trouble with the law. This past year I stayed in trouble with the law and finally they locked me up and my bond was set too high for me to be able to bond out. While I was in jail I began to read like most people do. Then one day a jail minister came by and gave me a short sermon and a Bible. I started reading God's Word all the time and then one day I had a breakthrough. My Pastor had got in touch with Project New Start in Newport and got me the paperwork. That night I prayed for god to help me with all my problems and to save me from my mess I had made and to place me somewhere that I could start my life over. That next day about 3:30 p.m. a deputy jailer pulled me out of my cell and told me I was accepted at PNS and that in a short time they would release me. My prayer had been answered. God placed me in a good place where I could start my life over and learn how to trust in God and learn how to deal with my problems through God's Word. The bottom line is that I was not a good husband to my wife or a good father to my children when I was living for the world and breaking God's Law. Now that I am putting god before all other needs I have a new life through Him. My family has been restored. My wife is very trusting in me and willing to walk in God's path with me. I can't tell you how much God is doing in my life since I have submitted to his will and not my own. I would like to thank God for all he has already done for me and thank him for placing me here. I would also like to thank everyone that has a hand in the ministry at PNS and for all that they have done for everyone in this program. The only way I have changed my life was with god's help. God changed my life and all I did was submit to him and he poured out His blessings upon me.

My name is Lisa Cooper and I am 36 years old. I have lived a life of chaos for the past 20 years. Five years ago, I lost my husband to a drug overdose, leaving me a single mother of three children. After my husband passed away, I started using drugs more heavily, sending me into a tailspin of destruction. I did things I said I never would do and hurt people that were the closest to me. I finally found myself sitting in a jail cell, crying out to God in complete defeat. He stepped in and I was accepted into Project New Start. I graduated the program June of last year. Throughout the six months of treatment, I developed a relationship with God and put my life completely in His hands. Brother Tim and Sister Leslie gave me the opportunity to move to the Hannah House 2 with my 3 beautiful children. This has been such a blessing to have a home and be able to provide for my children. I thank God for the restoration He has allowed in my kid's and my life.

Our names are Jennifer and Cody. We were to a point in our lives where we felt lost and that there was no hope. We entered this program together and it changed our lives forever. Once we started living for God he gave us blessings that we could never imagine. We are now happily married and have an awesome family life. He has blessed us with wonderful jobs and a group of great loving friends. Our children are now so happy and proud to call us their parents. We couldn't ask for more. All praise to God for the blessings and great changes in our lives.

The children call me Ms. Holly, I am the administrator of New Life Children's Home. I have been the administrator out here for almost a year. I came from DCFS as a Child Abuse Investigator Supervisor over child abuse where I worked for 12 years. I was doing Child Abuse investigations and for many years I witnessed children being abused and neglected. I felt the pain and hurt of the children when I looked into their eyes. God gave me the opportunity to come to New Life Children's Home and help the children who have been abused and neglected. It has been very rewarding to look into the eyes that were once hurt and broken and to see the light shine again. This is why I do what I do. I am 15 years old and most of my life my mom has been in and out of rehabs and prison. Luckily I always had my dad and grandma to go to. When I was 14 I got introduced to meth.
