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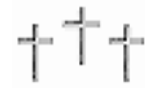

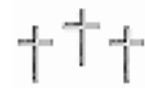

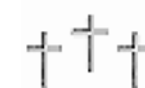

My name is Kelley Michelle Morris/Tounsley. I'm 42 years old and I'm the oldest of five children. I grew up being abused in many ways. When I reached the age of 16 I turned to drugs and alcohol. At the age of 39 in 2011 I came to Project New Start. This is where my new life began. I received Christ and a different view on life. Still on June 22, 2014 I am serving the Lord. He has blessed me with a husband, a car, a job, and we are buying our house. Thank you Jesus for what you do for me.

I am a single mom of 3. I grew up in a good home and was raised in church, but even though I knew better, I strayed away and for twenty years I let meth control my life. I wasn't a good mom, friend, or anything else. I wouldn't keep a job and my mom paid all of my bills. She enabled me without even knowing she was. I ended up in jail and DHS took my kids. I knew there was no way I could get out and stay clean. Getting high had taken everything that was important to me. I want to praise God for taking this junkie, cleaning me up and showing me how to be that Godly mother he always wanted me to be. Relationships with my family have been restored, I have a job, and I can finally be that mother that my kids can look up to. I've learned that the best thing you can do is to keep going and don't be afraid to get back up. Don't let a hard lesson harden your heart, there will be times when it seems everything that could possibly go wrong is going wrong. All my life my father struggled with the bondage of meth and it destroyed our family. He tried his best to keep me away from that demon and I did until I was 19. I found out I was pregnant in June last year and I had no intentions of ending my addiction or keeping my baby and that destroyed everything. My daughters father Adam and I split up because I'd planned to have an abortion. I started getting excited about having a baby, but that demon of mine was stronger. We had gotten in trouble and gotten out of it before but this time was different. Our PO came for a random house visit and we failed a drug test. We were arrested, taken to jail, and sentenced to rehab for a year. I had only done meth for 6 months and it had already made me a junkie and destroyed my life. In November I came here broken. My PO told me I wouldn't get to keep my baby and that Adam and I were to have no contact for the whole year. I've been here 7 months now. I had my beautiful, healthy baby named Arianna Alena which means “Holy Light” and she is here with me. She's 4 months old now. After five months of no contact, Adam was restored to me and my father has been clean the whole time I've been here. I have a happiness and strength I never had and I have become a great mother. God has restored everything to me and delivered me from all my weaknesses. God has gave me a new life!
